2. MTT Dash Divers were here for eight (8) days in early summer. Working along Clark Road they removed 200 bags weighing 65 pounds each. Weather was poor: rainy, windy, and stormy. The Kile family hosted the operation by providing a site for a motor home and an electric hook-up. Mike Smith did more work than was contracted. They took underwater movies. We expect a report. Check our website for the many lake surveys that RLS has done. Last survey was done in August 2020.
3. Discussion followed about these items.
4. Drainage ditch along Rick & Kathy Doud's property that flows into Lee Lake.
5. Quality of the water pumped into our lake from the Nottawa.
6. More phragmites need to be removed.

## New Business

1. To continue with MTT Dash Divers in 2022 we need money to put us on their list.
2. Discussion on need for better roads. Residents have vehicle damage. Chris Gallagher is working with Keith Eyre, Newton Twp. Trustee to improve Clark Road, I Drive South, and 10 Mile Road. We (the lake and/or township) have no funds or power over road repair.
3. Enzyme treatment of Milfoil is not chemical but natural clay based. Suction harvesting costs \$10,000 each time. Enzyme treatment cost unknown. We need to research this.
4. "Thank you, Mark Casebeer," Larry Vitale added.
5. Lee Lake Association will be neutral on any resident conflicts.
6. Rick Doud made a **motion to address the influx of agricultural land run off and drainage of wetlands into Lee Lake with attending residues herbicides, pesticides, fertilizers and tannins to illiminate those nutrients. The wetlands should serve as a sponge to absorb nutrients before lake entry.**

Chris Gallagher seconded the motion. Discussion. Motion carried.
