2. Lee Lake Public Landing will have a sign about invasive species placed by CISMA (Cooperative Invasive Species Management Area) when DNR allows it.
3. Office Supplies: Duane expressed a need for the association to pay for office supplies (stamps, envelopes, copies of newsletters and payment forms. Discussion. We could save postage by handing out correspondence to some members. Jan made a motion to give LLA Board \$200 for office supplies. Connie seconded it. Motion carried.
